



SUMMER ELECTRONIC BENEFIT TRANSFER (S-EBT)



S-EBT is a program that helps families buy groceries for school-aged children during the summer when school meals are not available. Families receive **\$120 per eligible child on an EBT card** that works like a debit card and can be used at grocery stores, farmers markets, and approved online retailers.

S-EBT benefits for Summer 2026 will begin issuing May 23, 2026 for all children who are automatically certified through streamlined data matching.



HOW S-EBT BENEFITS WILL BE ISSUED

- Benefits will be issued to an existing SNAP/TANF household EBT card if the child and primary guardian are on the same active case in February, March, or April 2026.
- If your child received Summer EBT in 2025, the benefit will go on the same card. If you lost the card, contact the Nevada S-EBT Customer Service Center for a new one. If the card was not used, a new card will be issued.

FOR NEW S-EBT CARDS

Cards may take 2-3 weeks to arrive.



IF YOUR FAMILY NEEDS TO APPLY FOR S-EBT

- A card will be mailed to you once your application is approved.
- Benefits will be available once the family receives the card.
- Benefits expire after 122 days after availability.



WHERE YOU CAN USE S-EBT BENEFITS:

Use your S-EBT card like a debit card at grocery stores, corner stores, and approved online retailers like Amazon, Walmart, and SaveMart (availability may vary).
